

Trauma Resident MUST CALL an Attending List.

- 1. Patient leaving against medical advice (AMA).
- 2. Significant changes in hemodynamics.
- 3. Respiratory distress/ hypoxia.
- 4. Rapid response or CODE BLUE.
- 5. Need for ICU upgrade.
- 6. Significant changes in labs (e.g. large hemoglobin drop, hyponatremia, hyperkalemia).
- 7. Altered mental status, change in GCS, with concerns for stroke or intracranial bleeding.
- 8. Patient is a danger to self/others.
- 9. Substance withdrawal.
- 10. Radiology contact regarding new imaging findings.
- 11. Multiple phone calls (3 or more) from nursing about the same patient problem.

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
