

Trauma Resident MUST CALL an Attending List.

1. Patient leaving against medical advice (AMA).
2. Significant changes in hemodynamics.
3. Respiratory distress/ hypoxia.
4. Rapid response or CODE BLUE.
5. Need for ICU upgrade.
6. Significant changes in labs (e.g. large hemoglobin drop, hyponatremia, hyperkalemia).
7. Altered mental status, change in GCS, with concerns for stroke or intracranial bleeding.
8. Patient is a danger to self/others.
9. Substance withdrawal.
10. Radiology contact regarding new imaging findings.
11. Multiple phone calls (3 or more) from nursing about the same patient problem.
