
Where do I find that....?

Where to find important pediatric materials in the Trauma Bay and Emergency Department

There are multiple supply rooms to be aware of when looking for pediatric supplies:

- 1) Trauma Bay room 1
- 2) The main Trauma Bay supply room
- 3) Room 51/52 in North Pod
- 4) Central/North Pod supply room
- 5) Critical Care Cabinet in the Trauma Bay


What are we looking for??



In the event of a pediatric trauma, you will ideally be in Trauma Bay room 1.

1a) View of the right-side of TB 1 from the doorway.

Red arrow and red circle show where critical pediatric supplies are located.






- 1b) Another view of the right side of TB 1 from the doorway.
- All sections within the red rectangles house pediatric supplies

• 1c) Along the right side of the TB (if facing the room from the doorway), you will find a silver table.





• 1d) On the silver table, you will find the pediatric thoracotomy tray.

There is only one in the entire emergency department! Please be aware if you move it, it needs to be put back



• 1e) Along the right side of the TB (if facing the room from the doorway), you will find a tan and brown linen cart.

• On top of this cart you will find the pediatric and neonate <u>internal</u> defibrillator paddles.

1f) Along the back wall of the TB to the right is a silver rack with supplies.

Pediatric supplies are on the shelf with neon pink tape.




- 1g) In the 1st and 2nd cubbies you will find:
 - pediatric trach trays
 - pediatric chest tube trays



- 1h) In the 3rd, 4th, and 5th cubbies you will find:
 - pediatric pigtails (8.5FR)
 - pediatric central line kits (4F, 5cm, 2 lumen)
 - pediatric central line kits (4F, 8cm, 2 lumen)






- In the event your patient is placed in a room other than TB room 1, you can utilize other supply areas, such as the Trauma Bay supply closet.
- This closet is located in the Trauma Bay across from room 5 and next to the water station.
- 2a) View of the Trauma Bay supply closet from the doorway.



2b) Another view of the TB supply closet from the doorway.

You will find pediatric supplies to the right side where the red rectangle and arrow are.



2c) Another view of the shelf that houses peds supplies within the TB supply room

2e) Located here are thoracentesis trays






• 3F 8cm, 21G 5cm arterial pressure monitoring set (location shown on previous slide)




3a) Critical pediatric supplies can also be found in the back of North Pod (the pediatric pod) of the ER in rooms 51/52. This room is often used as a pediatric resus room.

This is the view from the entrance of rooms 51/52. You will look for the silver cabinet in the back right corner – see the red circle.



3b) All of the items in this cabinet are extremely useful for pediatric resuscitations, but today we will focus on the sections in the red boxes.







- 7F 16cm triple lumen CVC kits
- 5F 13cm double lumen CVC kits
- 5F 8cm double lumen CVC kits







3d) Located in Bin #2 are:

- 4F 12cm double lumen CVC kits
- 4F 6cm double lumen CVC kits
- 4F 5cm double lumen CVC kits

• 3e) Located here are radial artery cath kits:








- 4b) This is the view from the inside of the central pod/north pod supply room. We are looking at the north pod door.
- The red arrows point to where you can find pediatric foley cath kits.







5) The Trauma Critical Care Cabinet houses important supplies. It is located across from TB room 2.

5a) You will find in the red rectangle:

- the REBOA kit
- DPA catheters

In addition, you can find the following in this cabinet:

- The IO kit
- More CVCs
- 9F cordis kits
- Sterile towels
- Gowns
- Probe covers
- Guide wires
- And much more!

5a) DPA catheters (aka peritoneal lavage sets) are located in the bottom shelf of the critical care cabinet.

These are special ordered so they are only kept here as of now.









• 5c) The REBOA kit can be found in the bottom of the Trauma Critical Care Cabinet
