Changes to Patient Assignments (Hospital Med)

- Patient placement is now Patient Placement & Assignment Team (PPAT)
 - The Med Capt role no longer exists
 - The assignment of patients to hospitalists is now done by the PPAT
 - ICU downgrades should be called to PPAT (520-694-6539)
 - ICU Downgrades should be called in by 3pm
 - Efforts to staff a Hospital Medicine ICU team to manage all downgrades as a point of contact and someone who would be stationed in Tower 1 has occurred. We are trying now to fill that day shift (7a-7p)
